What is our "fresh air policy?"

- Students, staff and visitors at Deans Community High School are entitled to breathe fresh air!
- * Smoking is not allowed at our school including the school grounds and entrances!
- * Smoking is the largest preventable cause of illness and early death in Scotland!

What will happen?

- Anyone found to be smoking within the school grounds will be reminded that DCHS has a "fresh air policy" and will be asked to stop.
- The individual will be reported to the head teacher/depute head teacher.
- They will be offered support from Pupil Support and also "Cloud 9" to stop smoking. Cloud 9 offer group appointments as well as individual appointments!

Cloud 9

- * Cloud 9 is a project designed to support and assist young people to reduce or stop smoking.
- * They offer:
- * Free and confidential advice
- * Advice and support from fully trained staff to help young people quit
- * Individual appointments
- * Nicotine replacement prescriptions can be arranged
- * Peer support
- * Stress management
- * Education and health promotion
- Ongoing support
- * If you are interested in receiving more information on Cloud 9, please see Pupil Support!



Breaches of the policy

- Students identified as smoking will receive a letter home. This letter will also have details of stop smoking support.
- Sharing/selling cigarettes is also prohibited at DCHS.
- No tobacco products should be brought to school (including e-cigarettes).
