

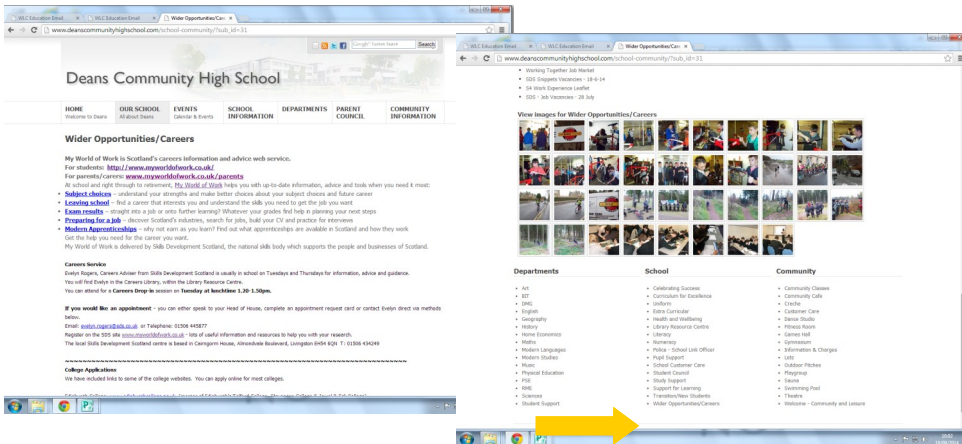

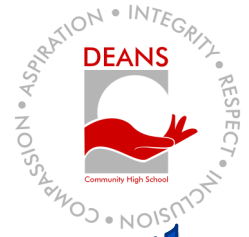

**Securing your future...**

**Opportunities for All** ensures access for all Scotland's young people to a range of opportunities, including staying on at school, national training programmes, university and college courses, Activity Agreements and additional opportunities offered through Inspiring Scotland, Community Jobs Scotland and Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) Jobcentre Plus. (Scottish Government, 2012)

**The purpose of this is:**

- ◆ *To improve young people's chances of finding long term work*
- ◆ *To improve young people's employability skills*
- ◆ *To reduce youth unemployment*
- ◆ *To support Scotland's economic growth*

## 16 + Learning Choices

### What does this mean?

16+ Learning Choices is a guaranteed offer of a place in learning for every young person who wants it and has reached their statutory school leaving date.

(**31st May** for those born between the 1st March and 30th September or **20th December** for those born between 1st October and 28/29th February)



### What is meant by Post-16 Learning?

- ◆ Education in school
- ◆ Full or part-time college education
- ◆ Full or part-time university education
- ◆ National Training Programme
- ◆ Full or part-time employment
- ◆ Personal Skills Development.



### How does it work?

A young person in school and approaching their statutory leaving date will be asked what they intend to do.

Support will be given to find an appropriate opportunity. The school will record this information and share it with Skills Development Scotland who can offer career information, advice and guidance before and after the young person leaves school.

It is therefore important that contact details are completed full

### How will Deans CHS support our students?
